It will bring new levels of refinement, sophistication and attention to detail to the segment, without any compromise on style or driving pleasure.

Featuring second generation Lexus Hybrid Drive technology, the CT 200h reinforces Lexus' hybrid leadership in the premium market, joining the RX 450h, GS 450h and LS 600h to create an unprecedented range of full-hybrid vehicles.

The Lexus LFA will also be on show at Geneva, offering the opportunity to review the critically-acclaimed supercar in Europe before the initial order period closes at the end of the motor show.

Lexus' press conference will be conducted by Mr. Andy Pfeiffenberger, Vice President Lexus Europe, and is scheduled for 16.45 on 2nd March, on Stand 4211 in Hall 4.
