
Scott Pruett

Scott Pruett has a long-standing partnership with Lexus as a Brand Ambassador. Pruett has assisted in the testing and development of Lexus vehicles and with the Lexus Performance Driving School. He is one of the most-decorated sports car racers in North America and has a storied history with Lexus. The veteran driver previously drove Lexus-powered prototypes from 2004 to 2009 in the Grand-Am Rolex Sports Car Championship Series where he won three driver's championships and the Rolex 24 at Daytona in 2007 and 2008. Overall, Pruett earned 60 North American sports car victories, including a record-tying five Rolex 24 at Daytona victories and is a five-time GRAND-AM series champion. He previously raced in IndyCar for 10 seasons (1988-1999) where he earned two wins, 15 podium positions and was the 1989 Indianapolis 500 co-rookie of the year. Pruett also raced part-time in NASCAR from 2000 to 2008. He's been inducted into two motorsports Halls of Fame since his retirement after 50 years of racing, including the Motorsports Hall of Fame of America and the West Coast Stock Car Hall of Fame. Pruett, who began racing go-karts in 1968, was also a three-time SCCA Trans Am champion in 1987, 1994 and 2003. He and his wife, Judy, wrote and published four children's books as well as own and operate Pruett Vineyards.
